Fourth Annual Research Day 2019 programme

The Fourth Annual Research Day of JIPMER, Pondicherry will be celebrated on 5th and 6th March, 2019 (Tuesday and Wednesday) in the JIPMER Academic Centre (JAC) Mini Auditorium from 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM. There will be an opportunity for presentation of research papers by UG students, postgraduate students, senior residents, research scholars and faculty. All students, residents, research scholars and faculty members of the institute are expected to participate in this program.

The following awards will be given during the function based on the research papers presented in the scientific session:

1. UG research award (s) (GJ STRAUS/ICMR presentations)
2. Postgraduate and senior residents research award (s)
3. Faculty research award (s)
4. PhD research award (s)

All UG students who have received the JIPMER Golden Jubilee-STRAUS Fellowship 2017-18 must present their research work during the UG session.

All post graduate students who have completed their thesis by January/February 2019 are encouraged to submit their thesis for the oral/poster presentation.

For faculty presentation, their papers should have been **published in the last two years** i.e. from January 2017 to January 2019 and it should be based on the research work done at JIPMER. The presentations will be oral /poster presentations.

For the postgraduate student, senior residents and PhD scholars, published work as per above mentioned criteria or unpublished work can be submitted. For published papers, the presenter must be an author of the paper submitted for presentation.

For the postgraduate student, senior residents and PhD scholars, the papers/ abstracts of unpublished work will be considered for oral/poster presentation.

All undergraduate presentations submitted under GJSTRAUS-2018 programme will be for ORAL presentation only. ICMR STS projects approved in the year 2017-18 can be submitted for POSTER presentations only. For ICMR projects, an undertaking signed by the guide to the effect that the report has been to ICMR should be submitted along with the abstract.

*All faculty/research scholars/residents/students can submit only **ONE** abstract for presentation. Only original work should be submitted for presentation. No case report/reviews/ other types of manuscripts will be considered.*

The format for submission of the abstract is given below. The word limit is 350 words (Arial/Font size 11/1.5 spacing). Background, Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results and Conclusions should be formatted in a single paragraph with respective subsections. A model abstract has been enclosed for reference. a) Criteria for consideration of award for residents (JR /SR), MSc, MPH, and PhD students presentation:

1. The postgraduate students, senior resident/PhD student can submit their unpublished work-thesis/original work as abstracts for submission. These will be considered for oral/poster presentation.
2. For published works, the postgraduate students, senior resident/PhD student should either be the first or the corresponding author of that paper. In case first author is not available the corresponding author can nominate in writing any co-author to present the paper. The research paper should have been published between January 2017 to January 2019 .The candidate must submit the full paper as a PDF file along with the abstract .The criteria for best paper would also include impact factor of the journal plus citations received for the paper.
3. The paper should be based on research conducted in JIPMER by the candidate. Papers published as original research; short communication or research letters are acceptable. Systematic reviews with meta-analysis will also be considered (systematic or narrative reviews alone without meta-analysis will not be accepted). Single patient case reports/short series (containing 10 or less patients), images, ultrasound corner and other minor articles will not be considered.

(c) Criteria for consideration of award for UG presentation:

1. It will be based on the presentation by the student for GJ

STRAUS. This will include a GJ STRAUS award of Rs.

10,000/- for each student.

Best paper awards will be given as like in other categories

to winners. ICMR paper presentations will be considered for

best poster award.
